CHAIRMAN'S WELCOME

I have great pleasure in welcoming you to this year's GWCT Scottish Auction.

This event has an honourable record now in its 29th year since its inspired inception by Anthony Fleming Smith and his initial committee. More than £2.5m has been raised over that period but for what is the organisation raising money?

To an extent the Trust may suffer, ironically, from being research focused and a charity. This status provides fiscal and credibility benefits, but it has perhaps placed limits on two things: its political activity, something by which other excellent field sport organisations are less limited, and the ability to directly benefit members. With no 3rd party insurance benefits, for example (although this may change), many wonder why they should join at all. "What's in it for me?"

I was recently privileged to attend the GWCT annual conference at Ragley Hall, near Cambridge, and was astonished by the breadth and depth of the trust's activities. For anyone interested in the countryside, its preservation and conservation, the Trust deserves recognition and our support. The Trust is actively involved in farming projects north and south of the border, as well as detailed research and conservation over an enormously wide range of the wild residents in the UK, as described by Dr. Adam Smith on page 5. The most effective counter to the often ill-informed, prejudicial and dangerous opinions which receive a depressingly high profile from often publicly funded organisations is factual evidence to refute the wilder allegations. This is but one dimension of the Trust's activities, whose reach out to the public is nowhere better seen than at its excellent Scottish Game Fair.

Those of us who rejoice in the privilege of enjoying rural activities owe it to the Trust to support its agenda. This dinner is one avenue of financial support, membership is another. Membership levels are woefully low for an organisation of this importance. Don't look at a subscription as a 'membership' assuring access to a gym, golf club or even a shoot. Look on it as a donation to a charity which is at the heart of bucolic activities in this country. Support the cause tonight by bidding enthusiastically - and over-generously if you can avoid the glare of your partner - but also by joining the GWCT. Subscription is a small price to help secure the future of Britain's wildlife.

We on the committee thank you for your support and hope you enjoy an evening which owes so much to the generous patronage of our donors and the support of James Thomson and Prestonfield Hotel. Just keep auctioneer Charles on his toes tonight!

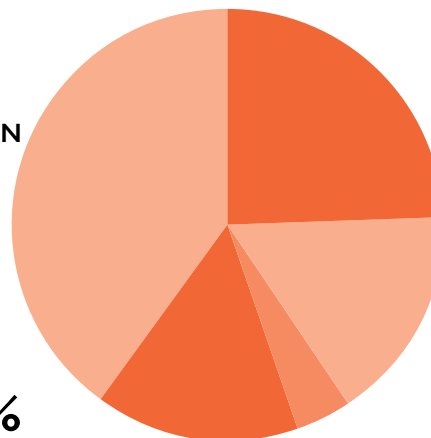

DIRECTOR'S CUT

My lord, ladies and gentlemen...

Most of you who come to this dinner will have a good idea of the time, knowledge and financial investment that it takes to manage land. A little of this knowledge might even be derived from the work of GWCT – perhaps you use minimum tillage on your farm, or control ticks and louping-ill on sheep.

There is a good deal of scepticism however, whether it is broadly understood that Scotland's cherished landscapes, habitats and species aren't the result of nature being protected from the hand of man, but the product of active, thoughtful management. So the GWCT's projects are aimed at supporting game shooting and wildlife conservation and making this activity clear:

1. **Game crops:** the single best thing a shoot can do to support wildlife through the hungry gap in the year when there's no other seed left. Developing new, cheap, effective, long-lasting game crops could revolutionise their use, especially as Brexit now offers us the chance of managing them more effectively. Our research is helping to improve your shooting and enjoyment of our wildlife.
2. **Big Farmland Bird Count:** over the 3rd–12th February farmers and shoots showed that they care about reversing the steep decline we have seen in farmland bird numbers. Over 970 farmers, around 100 in Scotland, spotted 130 species across just under a 1m hectares.
3. **Mountain Hares:** we have been working with SNH and the James Hutton Institute on hare research since 2007, to provide the facts that prevented Scottish Government banning mountain hare management.

4. **Lead shot:** thanks to the GWCT policy work you have supported in Scotland, lead shot has remained an option (provided you use it legally) and given us time to work towards alternatives.
5. **Muirburn:** we know that around 1m hectares of Scottish uplands (about 30% of the total upland area), is managed under rotational burning. This benefits mountain hares, golden plovers, rare lichens and mosses, spiders, beetles and daddy long-legs. Our input to consultations, committees and debates means your grouse moors can still be managed in this way.
6. **Crow control:** May is crow control season. GWCT are the only body to have thoroughly researched crow trapping; our most recent data shows crow control improves songbird breeding success by 11%. This year our research and policy work means that our gamebirds and songbirds should have fewer nests taken.

We can't undertake this and other vital work without your generous support. I hope that a good few of you will feel motivated to support the GWCT in 2017, and that you will pass on the word of what we are doing to your friends. Please enjoy the Scottish Auction.

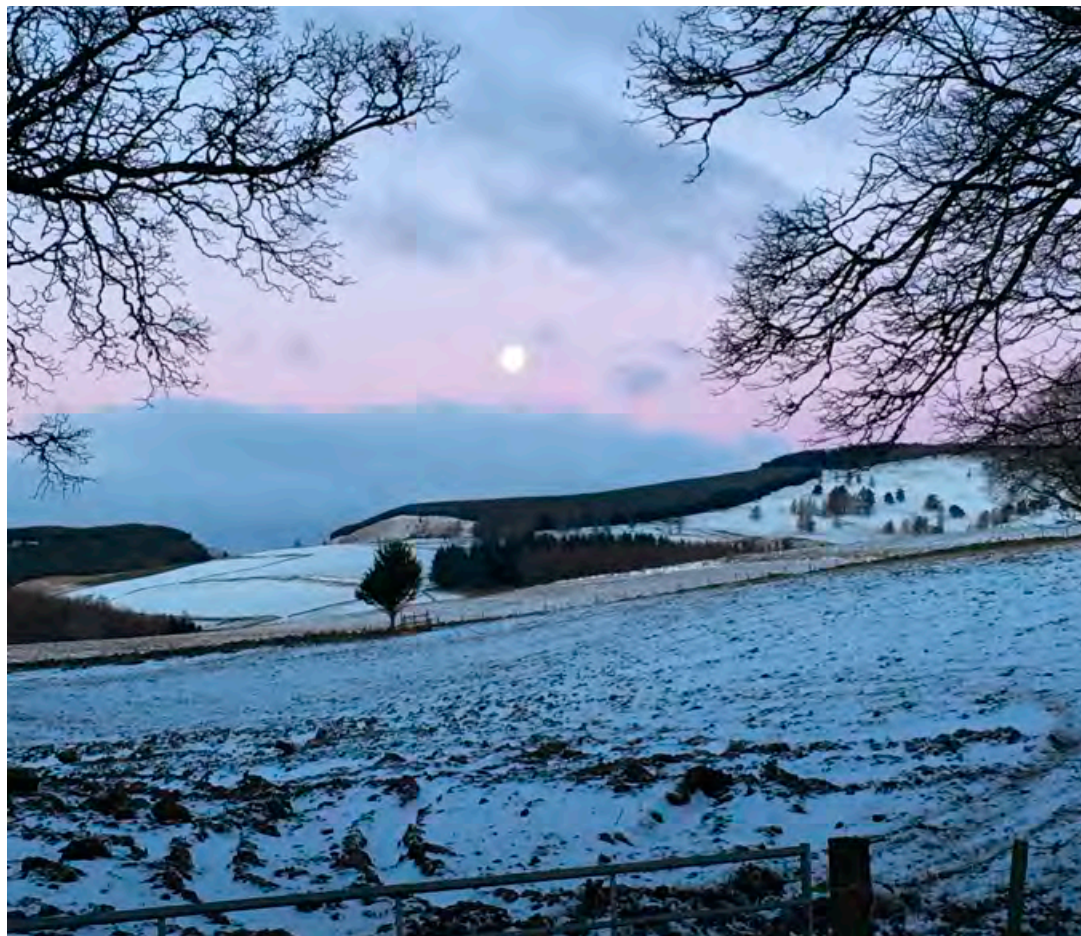

A DAY'S DRIVEN PHEASANT SHOOTING AT BROOMHALL, FIFE FOR 7 GUNS
