As I expressed last year, there has always been a problem with Ravens throughout

Repeated attempts to use scare tactics as a way to limit the damage they have caused has never worked. The only times we have really seen an improvement is when we have operated under our Raven licences for the past 2 years. This has had some impact on reducing the damage but has not solved it. Lambing is just around the corner and I feel that without a licence, we will have serious issues with ravens preying on new born lambs in the lambing fields and open hill.

So far this spring I have counted large number of Ravens on the Estate. These are as follows:

- 15th January 37 Ravens
- 28th January 52 Ravens
- 09th February 45 Ravens
- 21 February 58 Ravens
- 03 March 49 Ravens

It is clear that there are still large numbers of Ravens on the Estate.




